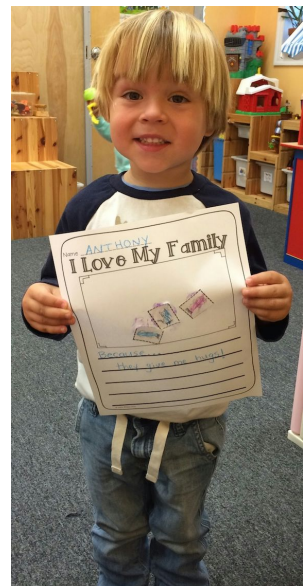
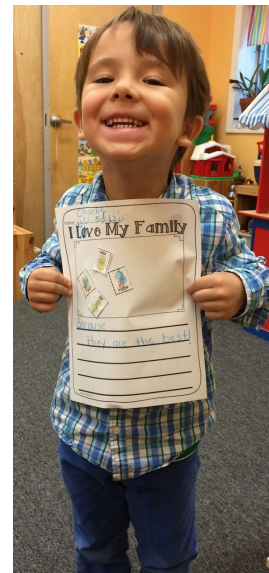
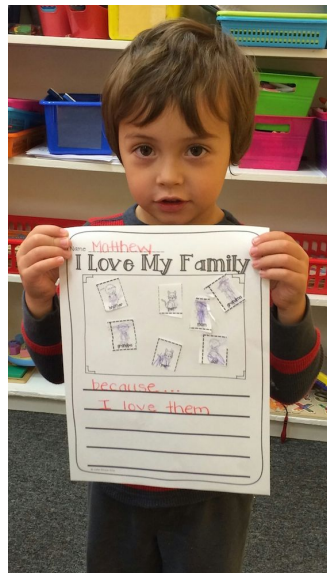
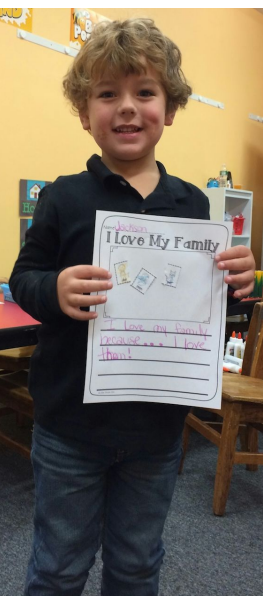
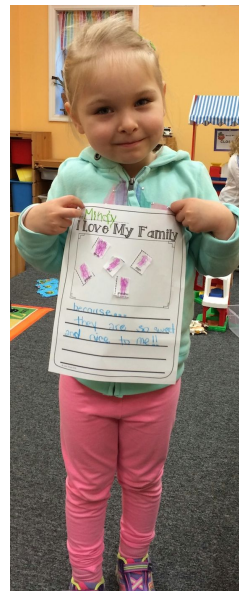
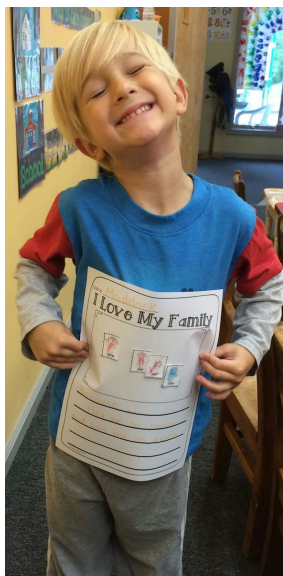
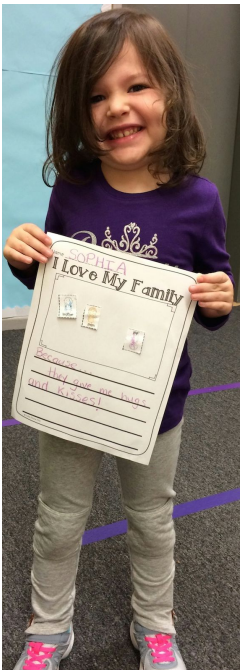
week of October 9th



This week we introduced our 2nd letter of the year, and it was **Ff**. we worked on what the letter F looks like, how to write, what sounds it makes, and we even came up with different words that started with the letter F.



we discussed our family and friends. who and what makes up a family, what families do for each other. Each student worked on their cutting skills with a I love my family worksheet. They first had to choose out of a list of family members who was in their family then color, cut and paste it on to their page. Afterwards the students told us why they loved their family. The students answers were too cute. . . For example we had a I love my family because they help me brush my teeth and a I love my family because they give me chocolate and I love my family because they give me lots of hugs!



Friends are very important here at the Rainbow Preschool. We made sure this week to talk about what it means to be friends and what friends do for each other. To help understand what friends are and what friendship means we watched a video of The book Rainbow Fish.



This story helped teach the students that sharing and caring are things we can all do that make our friends feel good. Even though the beautiful rainbow fish with shiny scales at first refused to share, after he did he realized how happy it made the other fish and because he shared they all wanted to be his friend and play.



Each student made their own unique Rainbow Fish with one shiny scale! All the Rainbow fish will be hung on the classroom wall in a school of beautiful friendly fish, each different and special in their own way.



This week since we were learning about the letter "Ff" we read My Letter "Ff" book written by Jane Belk Moncure. With this book the children learned about Little F and all the things she found to put in her box. After we read the story we went FISHING for pictures of things that start with the "f" sound.



Students this week also worked on letter F dot paint sheets. Where they learned how to write the letter F. This is a fun way for them to learn the formation of each letter we will be learning about.

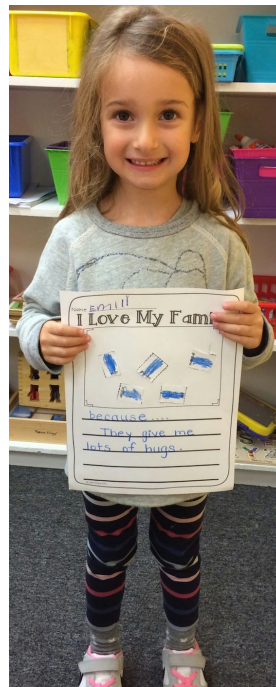


"Sleeping Fish"
